To inform licensing committee of a minor change to the street traders policy which was approved by licensing committee on 22nd February 2018.

The report considered by committee originally contained the following paragraph;

(c) Require a basis Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) disclosure, not less than one calendar month old, to accompany any new application for a consent. The applicant must also sign up to the DBS update service for the duration of the consent, and any subsequently renewed consent, so that the Council is able to monitor any change in circumstances. Where an applicant intends to employ any other person in the course of the business, then similar arrangements must be in place for each such employee.

Unfortunately the DBS update service is not available for basic disclosures. That service is only available when an enhanced DBS check has been carried out.

In view of this the Chief Operating Officer, Lukman Patel, using delegated powers, has approved the following amendment;

(c) Require a basis Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) disclosure, not less than one calendar month old, to accompany any new application for a consent. The applicant must also sign up to the DBS update service **as and when such service becomes available in relation to DBS basic disclosures** for the duration of the consent, and any subsequently renewed consent, so that the Council is able to monitor any change in circumstances. Where an applicant intends to employ any other person in the course of the business, then similar arrangements must be in place for each such employee.
