**Purpose** 

To obtain approval for the Council to submit an application to join a Lancashire bid for participation the 75% Business Rates Retention pilots for 2019/20

Reason For Decision

To seek authority to submit an application for participation in the Government's business rates pilot programme for 2019/20

The Council will be required to submit an application by the deadline of 25 September 2018.

Decision

That the Chief Executive uses urgency powers under Part 3 of the constitution as follows:

(1) Approval for the Council to submit an application to join a Lancashire bid for participation in the 75% Business Rates Retention pilots for 2019/20

(2) Approval to request for the Council to revert to participation of the existing Lancashire Business Rates Pool for 2019/20 and future years if the bid is unsuccessful.

The decision is urgent in order to allow the deadline to be met and is therefore not subject to call-in in accordance with Part 4.5 of the constitution.
