1. Finance and Property- Capital Works Update

Purpose To consider unavoidable additional works arising on the contract for capital works at Burnley Town Hall, and for the Chief Executive to use urgency powers under Part 3 of the Constitution (Council Functions) in consultation with the Mayor.

Reason For Decision To ensure that the works are progressed in a timely and cost-effective manner, reduce future unplanned maintenance costs and associated health and safety consequences of water penetration, to remove dangers from insecure masonry, and to protect both the heritage value and operational use of the Town Hall.
The reason for urgency is so that the works can be progressed in a timely manner and reduce unnecessary holding costs.

Decision (1) That the Chief Executive in exercise of his urgency powers under Part 3 of the Constitution (Council Functions) approves the proposed financing of the revised capital works as set out in the report to the 18th June 2019 Executive (Minute 14 refers); and
(2) That in accordance with the constitution the Chief Executive's decision be reported to the next meeting of Full Council to be held on 10th July 2019 for noting.
