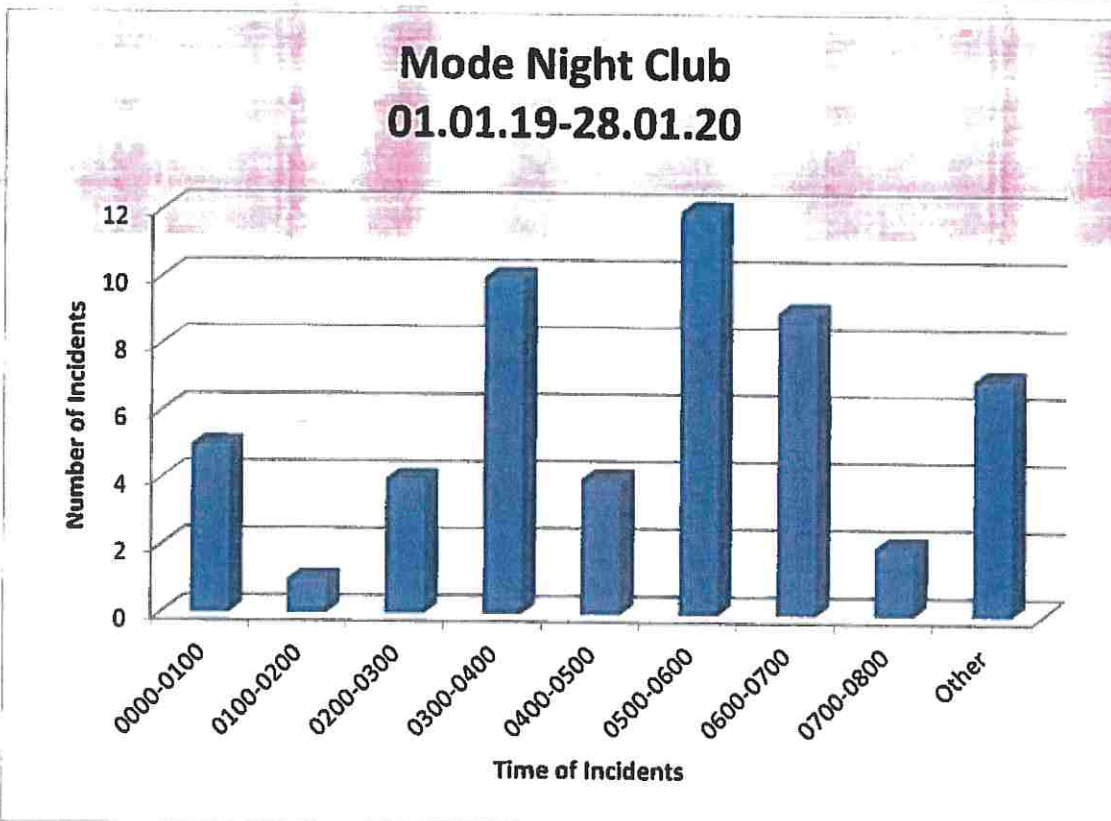

At 10:30 hours on the 5th February 2020, I Charlotte Ruddy handed the exhibits to PC Michael Jones.

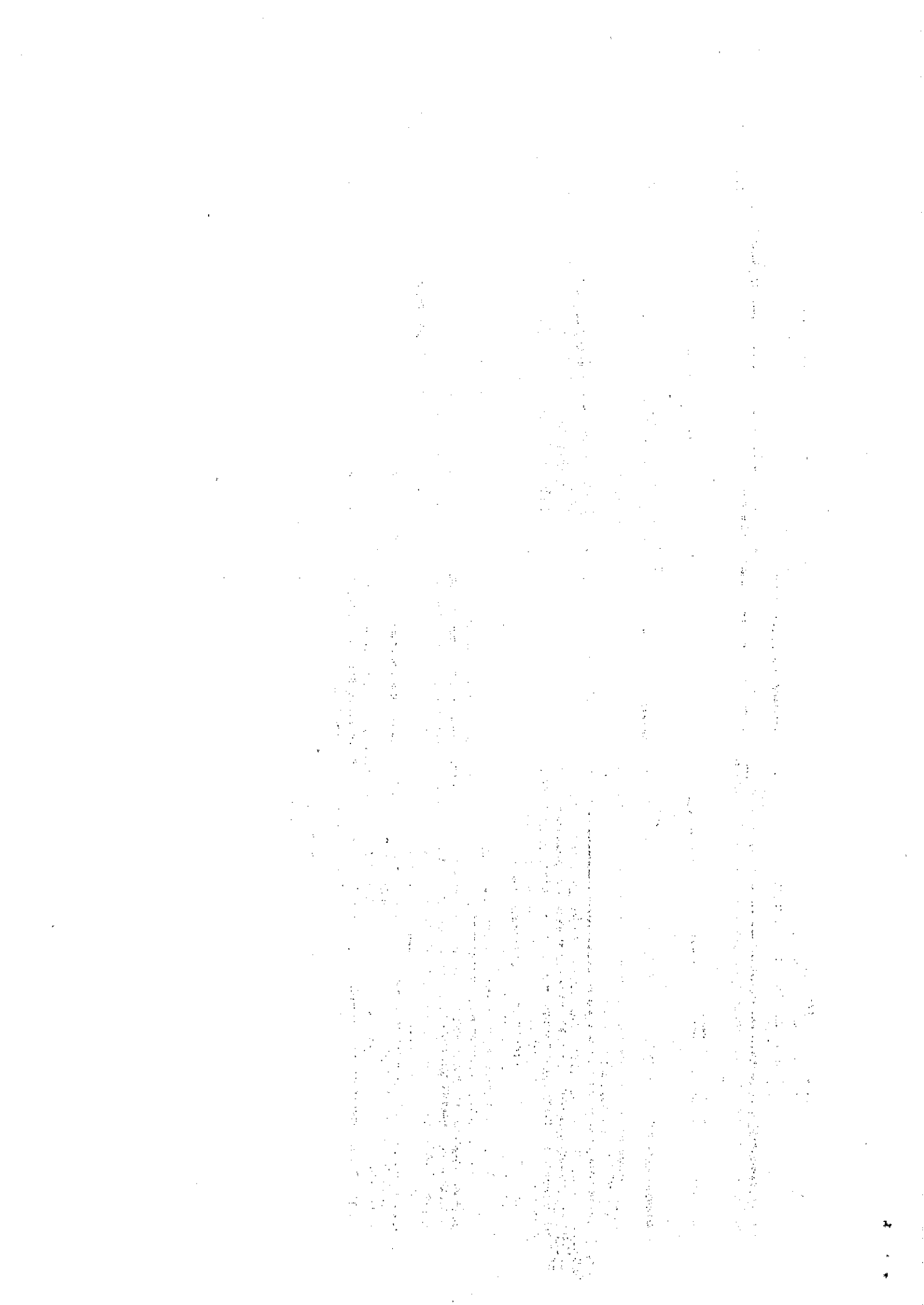

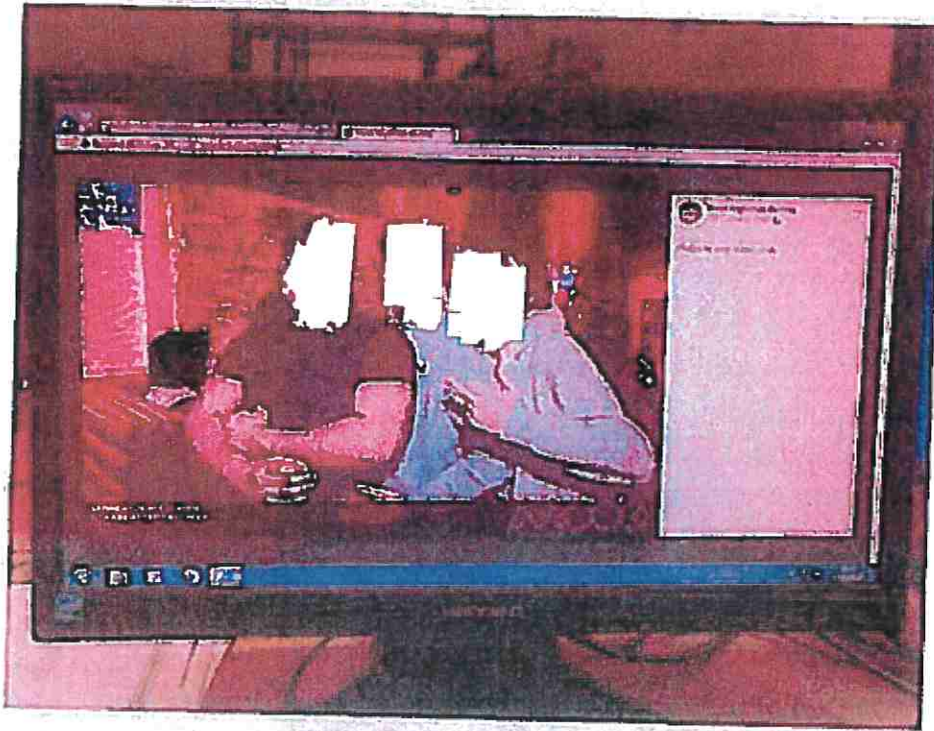
From viewing these photographs I can identify 6/2002, 004 and /2004 as I have dealt with all three previously on numerous occasions due to them causing Anti-social behaviour in the Burnley and Padiham area.

I immediately knew all three were under age and certainly shouldn't have been in these photos in a night club with adults drinking alcohol. is 17 years old, and both and are 15 years old. This creates safeguarding concerns due to their age.

I am Michael Jones, Police Constable 2623 of the Lancashire constabulary, currently stationed at Burnley Police Station. I am currently working within the East division Licensing department.

This statement relates to the failure by Rebecca Mc Quoid to provide CCTV as per her Licence conditions on 2 occasions.

Rebecca McQuoid is the Premises Licence Holder and Designated Premises Supervisor for MODE nightclub, Hammerton Street Burnley. The premises licence held on the Lancashire Police Innkeeper system is PLA0345.

Following a review hearing on the 12th of December 2017, conditions regarding CCTV are shown in ANNEX 3.

On the 15th of September 2019 a report was received from the Royal Blackburn Hospital raising concerns that a 17 year old female had been brought into the department in an unconscious state, possible due to having her drink "spiked "and potentially being the victim of a sexual assault. I became aware of the incident on Monday the 16th of September. The initial incident was investigated by an immediate response officer but there also appeared to be issues with the actions of the door staff and their care of the victim.

On the 17th of September I sent an email request to Rebecca informing her of the incident and requested that the CCTV for that night to be saved as part of the investigation. I did not receive any reply to this email and followed it up on the 19th of September with a further email with specific times of the incident that was being investigated. Once again I did not receive any reply. On the 20th of September I asked PS 3707 Hennighan to email Rebecca which he did and he received a prompt response. Within the Email Rebecca states that she was aware of the

female being taken away from the premises by the Ambulance service. On the 24th of September I sent Rebecca an email and received a response that she had taken me off her spam list and was receiving emails from me and she asked me if I was working the following day. I responded to that email with a request for the CCTV and Rebecca replied that she would "sort" that afternoon. I informed Rebecca that I was working until 3:30 the following day. Once again the CCTV was not forthcoming so a further email was sent to Rebecca on the 26th of September but no response was received.

On the 27th of September Sgt Hennighan sent a further email to Rebecca regarding the CCTV to which she replied,

"Gary,

I did email him letting him know it would be ready at 3:30pm on Wednesday, as I would be there. I require USBs for CCTV to be collected it cannot just be burnt off.

This had been the first time that I had been made aware the USBs were required and begs the question of how could the footage have been available at 3:30 if Rebecca did not have any USBs .

On the 29th of September there was a report of a Road Traffic Collision outside MODE. A voice message was left for Rebecca to recall the Police as we required a copy of the CCTV. Rebecca re contacted the Police the same day stating that the CCTV would be available between 11:00 and 19:00 on the 1st of October. Due to me collecting CCTV for the previous incidents I arranged to collect the CCTV but when I text Rebecca she stated that she was not in Burnley until the 2nd.

On the 2nd of October, together with Ps Hennighan I attended MODE and handed Rebecca 3 USB sticks and she assured me that she would leave them at Burnley Police Station on her way

home but again she failed to fulfil her promise. I text her at 08:38 on the 3rd of October but did not receive a response until the following afternoon where she told me that she had taken them home and would drop them off at the Police Station.

On Monday the 9th October I had still not received the CCTV so a further text was sent.

Rebecca stated that she had been ill and would drop the CCTV off on Tuesday but I received a text that she had been delayed at the bank but confirmed that I would have the CCTV that day but once again it has not materialised.

I have called Rebecca on the 3rd, 8th, 9th and 10th of October regarding the CCTV and every time she has promised to bring it in but never offered any explanation but indicated that the footage was in her car, so presumably it had been saved and copied. At no time has Rebecca stated that there has been a problem in obtaining the footage.

This has been the second occasion since the 15th of September that Rebecca has failed to provide the CCTV without any credible explanation as per the conditions in ANNEX 3 of her licence and due to the seriousness of one the allegations I feel that it adds to the gravity of the breach.

I have been made aware of more than one occasion where you have not complied with the specific condition relating to CCTV - the relevant condition is copied below

A colour CCTV system will be installed in the premises and will display on any recording the time and date of the recording and

- The system will be operated during all permitted hours
- The Camera's shall be sufficient in number to view all areas of licensable activity and any exit / entry and the area immediately outside the main entrance.
- Signs will be displayed in the premises to indicate that CCTV is in use and when dealing with incidents or unruly behaviour, staff shall indicate that CCTV is recording the incident.
- The system is kept in a working order, is checked regularly and any faults are rectified promptly.
- Images and Recordings are being kept for 28 days and will be available to the police or other authorised authority promptly upon request and there are staff trained that are able to access and operate the system and provide downloads.
- The recordings can be accessed and downloaded to another format (e.g. a USB stick or DVD or other recognised format)
- Requests for CCTV by the police will be made by either a personal request or an email request to the premises licence holder. This request will be acknowledged as soon as practicable and in any case within 24 hours of it being made and suitable arrangements will be made for viewing / copying and delivery of the relevant images back to the police as soon as reasonably practicable and in any case within 7 days of the initial request being made.

GIVEN THE RECENT CONCERNS REGARDING DOORSTAFF, AND THIS SITUATION WITH WELFARE CLEARLY BEING NEGLECTED AND UNDERAGERS BEING LET IN, I WOULD STRONGLY SUGGEST CHANGING DOOR TEAM.

SECONDLY, I BELIEVE A POLICY OF IDING EVERYBODY WHO ENTERS THE CLUB REGARDLESS OF CH25. IF I WENT TO A DANCE MUSIC CLUB IN LONDON/MANCHESTER, I WOULD EXPECT TO SHOW MY ID – EVEN AT MY OLD AGE – AS THIS IS A POLICY ADOPTED FOR PUBLIC SAFETY/ PREVENTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM. THIS IS SOMETHING I HAVE WITNESSED FIRST HAND AT WAREHOUSE PROJECT, FABRIC, MINISTRY TO NAME A FEW.

THIRDLY, A SERIOUS CONSIDERATION ON POLICIES AROUND MEDICAL ISSUES.

A REVIEW WOULD LEAVE YOU VULNERABLE AND IF WORST CASE SCENARIO HAPPENED (REVOCATION OF LICENCE), I WOULD NOT LIKE THIS AS I THINK IT WOULD BE A MASSIVE HIT FOR BURNLEY AND EAST LANCS NIGHTLIFE IN GENERAL. The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children-

- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or

- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

The responsible person shall ensure that-

- (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been

made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-

- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price

CCTV

A colour CCTV system will be installed in the premises and will display on any recording the time and date of the recording and

- The system will be operated during all permitted hours
- The Camera's shall be sufficient in number to view all areas of licensable activity and any exit / entry and the area immediately outside the main entrance.
- Signs will be displayed in the premises to indicate that CCTV is in use and when dealing with incidents or unruly behaviour, staff shall indicate that CCTV is recording the incident.
- The system is kept in a working order, is checked regularly and any faults are rectified promptly.
- Images and Recordings are being kept for 28 days and will be available to the police or other authorised authority promptly upon request and there are staff trained that are able to access and operate the system and provide downloads.
- The recordings can be accessed and downloaded to another format (e.g. a USB stick or DVD or other recognised format)
- Requests for CCTV by the police will be made by either a personal request or an email request to the premises licence holder. This request will be acknowledged as soon as practicable and in any case

Door supervisors

Prior to each occasion that licensable activities take place at the premises a risk assessment will be carried out to determine how many door supervisors are necessary. As a guide there should be at least two SIA registered door supervisors for the first 100 customers and then a further one for every additional 100 customers after that. An appropriate number of SIA registered door supervisors will be utilised in accordance with said risk assessment, which will be documented and made available to an authorised officer upon request.

As a minimum, at least two SIA Registered door supervisors will be utilised at the premises on whenever licensable activities are taking place from 22:00hrs until thirty minutes after the last customer has left the premises.

When licensable activities take place after 4am there will be a minimum of 4 SIA registered door supervisors working.

Door supervisors will use clear visible counting devices at all times when the premises are open. Counting equipment and current numbers to be open to inspection by police at any time when in operation.

All door supervisors will be equipped with Body Cam type cameras and will record all ejections and issues with customer. Images from these cameras will be made available as soon as practicable on request from the Police.

When on duty, door supervisors will ensure that no customers leave the premises with open containers.

Door supervisors to wear high visibility clothing with the premises being situated on a busy road. This also allows CCTV to spot the door staff for personal safety.

1. A record shall be kept on the premises by the DPS of every person employed on the premises as a door supervisor. The record shall contain the following details: name, address, date of birth and SIA licence number and signing in and out for each door supervisor. The record shall be available for inspection, on demand, by an authorised officer of the council, a police officer or the SIA.

Drugs Policy

The premises licence holder shall have a written policy in relation to drugs which will include search, seizure and disposal of drugs and weapons. The policy will be available for inspection on demand by an authorised officer of the Council, Police or SIA.

Closing times and facilitating the safe passage home of patrons

There will a clear customer dispersal policy in place. Such a policy should minimise noise disturbance and potential disorder from customers leaving the premises. A policy should clearly set out measures to control the exit at the end of the evening.

The premises will cease the selling of alcohol and will close at 6am with all patrons leaving the premises as soon

as practicable and in any case within 30 minutes.

The premises will link in with at least one local private hire / taxi service to provide a taxi Freephone to assist the booking of vehicles so that people can leave the premises quickly and safely.

Protection of Children

Unless agreed in writing by the Police all events at the premises shall be strictly over 18's only with no person who is under 18 years being admitted to the premises whilst licensable activities are taking place and door supervisors will verify the ages of every person seeking to gain admission to the premises unless they are clearly over 25 years of age.

The premises shall give a minimum of twenty eight days written notice to Lancashire Constabulary Licensing Department of any function targeted predominantly at persons under the age of eighteen.

All persons who appear to be under the age of 25 years shall be required to produce proof of age by way of the following:

- A recognised proof of age card accredited under the British retail consortiums proof of age standards scheme (PASS)
- Photo driving licence
- Passport
- Citizen card supported by the Home Office
- Official ID card issued by HM Forces or European Union member state bearing a photograph and birth date of the holder.

A notice or notices shall be displayed in the premises where they can be clearly seen and read and shall indicate that it is unlawful for persons under 18 to purchase alcohol or for any person to purchase alcohol on behalf of a person under 18 years of age.

Incident log to be kept on site and shall be maintained to record all challenges and refused sales.

Staff training

All staff who are involved in the sale of alcohol will receive training in relation to the licensing objectives so as to reduce crime and disorder, promote public safety, prevent public nuisance and promote the protection of children from harm. Said training will be documented and will be made available to an authorised officer upon request.

People who are clearly under the influence of alcohol will not be sold any more and will only be allowed to consume free tap water as their next drink.

Adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials is available on the premises. At least one suitably trained first-aider shall be on duty when the public are present.
