CLOSURE OF BURNLEY MARKET

Purpose To seek approval to close Burnley Market Hall until further notice due to the

current coronavirus outbreak.

Reason For Decision

On Monday the 22nd March the Government announced new measures to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus. This included the closure of all indoor and outdoor markets except for market stalls offering essential retail

such as grocery and food.

Decision That the Chief Executive uses Executive urgency powers under Part 3 of

the constitution as follows:

(1) Approves the closure of the market with immediate effect except for a small area remaining open for the sale of fresh food.

The decision is urgent in order to comply with guidance and is therefore not subject to call-in in accordance with Part 4.5 of the constitution.
