

Email from Premises Licence Holder to Licensing

Dear [REDACTED],

As you may be aware my company has leased this property to {DPS} and [REDACTED] on a long term 10 year lease.

[REDACTED] is the DPS. They have the complete premises and I moved out of there in 2017 when they took over.

I am currently working in Ireland address below, and am locked down here due to the outbreak of the Corona Virus.

It is my understanding that {DPS} closed the premises at the behest of the government in or around the 23<sup>rd</sup> March and she left the upstairs of the property occupied by a manager for security purposes {DPS} herself was not in occupation.

I was informed on Tuesday that there was some incident at the premises on Monday without {DPS} knowledge permission or approval and she immediately took the only action she could by removing the offending party from the premises .

I have no involvement in any day to day operation of the premises since leasing same, and condemn the actions of the manager in the current crisis.

I would sincerely hope that {DPS} the landlady's actions are enough so that she will be allowed to retain her status as DPS of the property without further penalty.
