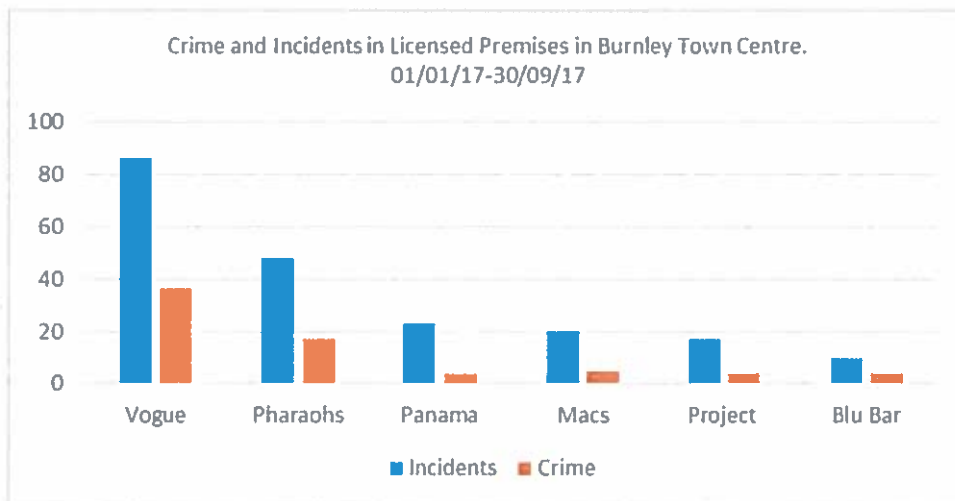
Crimes and incidents for were downloaded between 01/01/2017 and 30/09/2017 for the following locations, Hammerton Street, Cow Lane and Hargreaves Street in Burnley.

Crimes and incidents for licensed premises in these areas were filtered out, the following licensed premises were considered:

- Vogue, 77 Hammerton Street.
- Macs, 10 – 14 Hammerton Street.
- Blu Bar, Cow Lane.
- Panama, 19 Hammerton Street.
- Pharaohs, 20 Hargreaves Street.
- Project Bar, Hammerton Street.

Graph 1 below, shows the number of crimes and incidents that occurred in the above licensed premises in Burnley town centre between 01/01/2017 and 30/09/2017.

As can be seen from the graph above, the highest number of crimes and incidents occurred at Vogue nightclub during this time period.

#### Vogue

There were a total of 302 incidents recorded on Hammerton Street in Burnley between 01/01/2017 and 30/09/2017. Of these 28% (86) occurred at Vogue Nightclub.

In relation to the incidents on Hammerton Street, the highest number of incidents occurred between 0400 hours and 0459 hours (46). Between 0500 hours and 0759 hours, there were a total of 50 incidents on Hammerton Street.

In relation to the incidents at Vogue, there were 86 in total. The highest number of incidents at Vogue were between 0500 hours and 0559 hours (14). Between 0500 hours and 0759 hours, there were 36 incidents recorded, this is 41% of all incidents recorded at this location.

72% (36) of all incidents that occurred on Hammerton Street between 0500 hours and 0759 hours occurred at Vogue.

There were four incidents reported between 0400-0459 hours, this is a peak time for incidents at other locations on Hammerton Street.

The most frequent type of incident reported to the police at this location were assault incidents (30), followed by theft (8)

There were a total of 102 crimes reported on Hammerton Street during the same time period, of these offences, 34% (35) occurred at Vogue nightclub.

The most common offences to occur at the Vogue nightclub were assaults with injury (18) and theft offences (8).

Almost all of these offences occurred within the early hours of the morning. The victims were more likely to be males in their late teens and early 20s.

### **Pharaohs**

The licensed premises with the next highest number of incidents in Pharaohs on Hargreaves Street in Burnley.

During this time period there were 115 incidents recorded on Hargreaves Street in Burnley, of these 48 occurred at Pharaohs.

Almost 30% (14) were assault incidents. There were nine police generated incidents, these were predominantly officers requesting a van as someone had been arrested, requesting an ambulance or requesting more patrols to the area.

There were 33 crimes on Hargreaves Street during the time period considered. Of these crimes, 17 occurred at Pharaohs and 12 were violent crimes.

### **Panama**

In Panama, there were 23 incidents recorded between January and September 2017. The highest proportion of there were in relation to assaults (7), suspicious circumstances (4) and Nuisance (4).

There were two crimes reported during this time period. One assault without injury and one violence with injury.

### **Macs**

There were a total of 20 incidents reported at Macs. The highest number were in relation to Police generated activity whereby police requested further services such as more patrols or an ambulance. Following this the highest number of calls were in relation to lost or recovered property.

There were five crimes reported at Macs, there was no crime type that was repeated at this location.

### **Project**

There were 17 incidents at Project Bar. The highest number of these were police generated resource activity (4). This is due to officers requesting support or additional services. This is followed by assault (3).

There were four crimes recorded at Project bar. Two were assaults, one harassment and one theft offence.

### **Blu Bar**

Blue bar had the lowest number of incidents of all of the licence premises considered. There were a total of ten. There were two police generated incident and two assault incidents. Most of the incidents occurred at night or in the early hours of the morning.

There were four crimes recorded at Blu Bar, there were three assault with injury and one personal robbery offence. All of the aggrieved were males in their late teens / early 20S.

This statement is given in relation to problems that I have been made aware of at Vogue on Hammerton Street Burnley.

The first incident that I was made aware of occurred on the 2nd September 2017 at 07.30 am whereby a male by the name of Adam Cross made an allegation that he had been assaulted at the club and that there was a hate element to the crime. This was recorded under crime reference number EF1710006.

Due to problems with CCTV at the premises in the past a local arrangement had been put into place whereby officers investigating matters at the premises were expected to request any cctv via an e-mail set up by the club at: [voguecctv@outlook.com](mailto:voguecctv@outlook.com)

A request was made by PC 606 Ingham immediately following the assault; however he had received no response.

This matter was later followed up by the Hate Crime and Community Cohesion Unit, but they had had no luck in making contact with the Designated Premises Supervisor Rebecca McQuoid on either her mobile telephone, personal e-mail or the one mentioned above.

As part of the investigation into this offence, on the 9th September 2017 I requested PC 1361 Mountford to attend the night club to secure the cctv that they had of the incident, which they should have had recorded as part of their licencing conditions.

PC Mountford reported back to me that she had attended the club and had spoken to the Designated Premises Supervisor Rebecca McQuoid and had left her with a USB stick in order that the CCTV be downloaded.

Whilst speaking to a doorman I saw a ginger haired male walk from the premises with a large wound to his head and he was covered in blood, this male was extremely drunk and he informed me that he had been assaulted inside the premises

Whilst I was there an offender was identified by a member of the public as an offender and was subsequently arrested.

The two door staff that were on duty were informed that there were a further two offenders inside and they were requested to enter and look for the offenders.

After a short amount of time I entered the premises in order to establish if the door staff were OK as they had not returned back to the door. I was informed by one of the door staff that the offenders had been ejected.

I queried as to why neither had been pointed out to any of the police officers who had been stood at the front door of the premises awaiting to arrest them, the door staff could not give me an answer.

I found out the following day that the male who had been assaulted had suffered from a broken spine and extensive internal bleeding along with the wound to his head.

I am satisfied that the club are in contravention of their licencing conditions and I am happy that the licencing committee be made aware of the content of this statement.

You will recall that I sent you a letter regarding CCTV at the end of May 2017 and when I visited you on the 5<sup>th</sup> June at your premises I gave you a copy of that letter and some posters to display regarding CCTV.

Since that date both myself and Sgt Middleton have asked you to make contact on several occasions by email, text and attempted phone calls to arrange a visit to Vogue Burnley to check your CCTV equipment, the coverage, and quality and also to make sure it was being stored for the time period required.

This arrangement needs to be made as soon as possible and we are concerned as to the inability of the Police to be able to have conversations with you in a timely manner and the lack of response to communication is a major concern.

**We reserve the right to instigate a review of the premises if things do not dramatically improve.**

I therefore require you to make contact by email immediately – providing an email address that will be responded to, we also require a land line and a mobile number, and your correct home address.

This is required within 48 hours of this letter being delivered to your premises.

Premises Licensed under the Licensing Act 2003 to supply alcohol on the premises – CCTV system conditions of your Premises Licence

The Lancashire Constabulary and Burnley Borough Council Licensing Department are doing some joint work in the Burnley Borough to ensure that where a Premises Licence has a CCTV condition that the system is working and, should there be an incident, suitable images are captured that can be saved and downloaded to be used in potential criminal proceedings.

We are therefore informing you as Premises Licence Holder / Designated Premises Supervisor that we need you to check your CCTV systems and make sure

- They are working
- Recordings are being kept for as specified period (many of which are specified in the Premises Licence)
- That the recordings can be accessed and downloaded to another format (USB stick or DVD)
- That there are staff trained who are able to access and operate the system and provide downloads upon request by the Police or other authorised people.

The recording of incidents in the premises form part of most if not all Premises Licences and I would recommend that your individual premises licence is looked at to make sure that you comply with the conditions.

Best practice for CCTV systems is duplicated below

**The licensed area of the premises shall be equipped with a tamper Proof, Closed Circuit Television system (CCTV), which should comply with the following criteria.**

- 1. It will record to a Digital Video Recorder (DVR), with an evidential burn to Compact Disc (CD) or Digital Versatile Disc (DVD) with software facility.**
- 2. The CCTV Digital Video Recorder (DVR) will always be connected to a colour monitor that will be maintained in good working order in order to facilitate the viewing of any CCTV recording at the premises by the Police or any member of staff from the local authority.**
- 3. A member of staff will be trained and will always be present when the premises are open for licensable activity in order to download the images from the hard drive to disc.**
- 4. The full CCTV operating system will be maintained in proper working order. Any faults will be rectified without delay.**
- 5. It will be a colour system and will display on any recording the time and date of the recording.**
- 6. The system will be operated during all permitted hours.**
- 7. Recordings will be held for 28 days; thereafter the DVR can be allowed to**

overwrite if desired.

**8. The 28 day recorded data to be made available to police or local authority licensing officers for inspection and retention on request.**

**9. Camera's shall be sufficient in number to view any area for licensable activity and any exit/entry and the area immediately outside the main entrance.**

**10. CCTV cameras will be robust and conspicuous in presence.**

**11. Signs are displayed in the premises to indicate that CCTV is in use and when dealing with incidents or unruly behaviour, staff indicate that cctv is recording the incident.**

You will also be aware of the potential for CCTV images to deter poor behaviour, assist in the prevention of disorder and also to also assist in wider criminal investigations.

We would therefore request you co-operation in making sure that if visited by Burnley Council Licensing Officers or staff from Lancashire Constabulary that your system will pass the inspection.

In the forthcoming months before summer there will be visits taking place, and some of these will have a Police CCTV expert in attendance to make sure the system is appropriate and is fully functional.

We are giving advance notice of this work so that you can do what you think necessary now to ensure your systems are compliant with the licence conditions attached to your premises licence.

If premises fail or fall short of what is expected then that can lead to a review of the premises licence and then the Licensing Committee could then be asked to revoke your licence.

This email is to inform you that I have started collating evidence and statements with a view to submitting a review application for Vogue Night Club. I have serious concerns that the Licensing objectives are being undermined at your premises.

I cannot ignore the constant complaints I get from officers in regards the CCTV at your premises. There is quite a strict condition attached to the licence (see below) which I can evidence is being breached on a regular basis. The main problems being that access to CCTV footage is difficult to obtain and on other occasions the CCTV hasn't been working as it should. I can show that investigations into a number of recent allegations of assaults which have occurred in your premises have not had progressed as they should due to the lack of evidential CCTV. Good effective CCTV is a deterrent and quite simply too many victims are being let down at the moment.

*ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS IMPOSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE & UNDER PARAGRAPH 18(4) & 18(5) SCHEDULE 8 LICENSING ACT 2003 CCTV SHALL BE INSTALLED IN THE PREMISES AND SHALL RECORD BOTH INTERNALLY AND EXTERNALLY. MUST BE RECORDING AT ALL TIMES THE PREMISES IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. A STAFF MEMBER WHO IS CONVERSANT WITH THE OPERATION OF THE CCTV SYSTEM WILL BE ON THE PREMISES AT ALL TIMES THAT LICENSABLE ACTIVITIES ARE TAKING PLACE. THE FOOTAGE IS TO BE RETAINED FOR A PERIOD OF 28 DAYS AND ANY FOOTAGE MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE POLICE UPON REQUEST.*

I am also concerned about the increase in incidents which can be linked to your premises after 5am in the morning. It's safe to say that there's a higher percentage of incidents at your premises in the last 3 hours of your nights trading compared to your first 5 hours. A quick look at incidents which can be linked to your premises this year indicate that about 60% of the incidents occur after 5am and worryingly 35% are in the final 2 hours of your night (after 6am). This indicates to me that for some reason the behaviour of your customers deteriorates dramatically the longer they are in your premises.

Anything you can suggest or put forward in regards alleviating my concerns mentioned above will be appreciated otherwise a review application will be forthcoming.

As part of my routine duties I deal with applications, requests to change and review hearings of licensed premises.

Within my area of responsibility is Vogue Nightclub 77 Hammerton Street, Burnley.

This is the only Licensed premises in East Lancashire that regularly is open until 8am.

I was made aware of a review of the Premises Licence for Vogue triggered by Sgt Jason Middleton from the Lancashire Constabulary.

I made contact with the North West Ambulance Service (NWAS) in October 2017 as I was aware of the high number of times emergency ambulances had been called to Vogue at busy weekends.

I therefore asked for six different types of information and the results are below :-

Number of incidents where emergency ambulances were dispatched to Vogue broken down by priority

Time period for this was 1st Jan 2017 to 31st July 2017 (Latest data available for this query)

She stated the system hadn't been recording for the first week and it's only just been switched on therefore it hadn't recorded on the date requested which again I find hard to believe as this all new quality system has been set up and Officers and licencing have meant to have been involved. I feel like she's covering up as it's highly likely it was a member of door staff that carried out the assault and even if it wasn't the victim states he was assaulted at the front door in front of door staff and they did nothing. Further to this I asked the lates sergeant on the day of the incident to attend and recover the CCTV stressing it was a nasty homophobic assault and all I got back was an email stating there is a new process and I would have to email.

Morning Sgt,

I was hoping you could take a look at this log from Vogue from a licensing point of view. I was called to Vogue after a member of the public informed the police that the door staff were being too aggressive with customers. After speaking with the sober parties in the area, it appeared the door staff ejected 2 males lawfully after they were causing issues. However, as I was trying to investigate the incident, The owner Jason Mcoid was very obstructive, abusive and even threatening to "twat" people. He also threatened to "have my badge" as I tried to gain information on what had happened. There was no need for his behaviour to be this way and made the situation worse.

I'm not sure what you can but thought I would let you know as the issues needed to be brought to light. Any issues or questions let me know.

I was asked to check CCTV at VOGUE HAMMERTON STREET, BURNLEY in relation to the above log. It is a complaint of assault by door staff- a third party reported door staff kicking a male while he was on the floor and then assaulting a second male by dragging him across the road. The original attending officer has put comments on the log about the owner of the premises being 'obstructive, abusive, and making the incident worse with his aggressive attitude'.

I have attended VOGUE during opening hours and requested the CCTV from the night. I was informed by door staff that no one was present to make this available. Is it part of their licencing conditions that it is readily available? Also is there anyone that regularly has contact with their management that may be able to obtain this footage before it disappears? It was around 05:55 hrs on 12/03/2017 outside the front of the club.

---

Hello,

In response to your email about problems with Vogue, I have been having a few problems with them myself recently. I am trying to deal with an assault (LC-20170312-0295) whereby a male has alleged

he and his friend were kicked and punched by door staff after being ejected. A statement was obtained from the victim a long time ago and my next enquiry was to review the CCTV to see if there had been any offences I needed to investigate further, or if it was a lawful ejection.

It took me a while to get hold of the CCTV due to no one being there able to work it when I went. However, once I had emailed someone in licencing I came back on duty and someone had collected it/ it had been dropped off. I viewed it and the quality was poor as there is a colour changing light right in front of the camera so you wouldn't be able to make out an identification. This wouldn't have been a major issue as we knew who was involved but the footage I was given (with the correct date & time stamped on it) did not show anything happening at all. I know that the police definitely came out at the time as it was on the log and the officers confirmed it so the footage should have at least showed them arriving, even if the incident didn't play out as the victim stated. The only thing that I can think of is that either the time and date are totally out on the system or that it has somehow been altered to show a different time so it appears that nothing has happened, however, I haven't been able to prove that.

---

My son was assaulted in Vogue Nightclub in Burnley on the night of 30th April/1st May 2017. He took a single punch to the side of his face from behind and was knocked unconscious. As a result of the single punch, his jaw was broken and had to have surgery at The Royal Blackburn Hospital to put a metal plate in his jaw. .

The assailants were wearing masks which were sold inside the club and also made identification difficult.

I have been made aware that there was a delay of several days before the CCTV was taken and it was blank. Apparently it was not recording that particular night. Surely there must be something that states CCTV should be recording - especially at the weekend when trouble is likely. My son was an innocent victim and should have been safe in the club or at least someone should have been overseeing the safety of the guests and therefore been in a position to apprehend the attacker, who was able to leave unidentified.

I feel that the club have a duty of care and my son has had a terrible experience. It looks increasingly likely that there will be no arrests made. No-one called the police at the time which I don't understand and according to xxxx when my son and his friends were taken outside the bouncer warned them not to go in a certain direction as the attackers were waiting. The bouncer must have been able to provide some form of identification.

I am quite devastated having seen the anguish my son has gone through - not just physically but mentally too.

I appreciate that you are very busy and in the grand scheme of things this is just a tiny incident but I feel I have to speak up or these people just carry on taking the law into their own hands.

I feel that the licence of this club should be revoked or at least questioned. Please can you advise what I should do. Thank you.
