To whom it may concern.

We wish to make representations, please see below;

On 04/11/2016 officers entered the premises at 18:00 hrs. Consent was requested.

The 1 male in the shop picked up his mobile phone as if to call the manager but then proceeded to leave the premises by the rear.

The subject was arrested and escorted back into the premises.

Checks showed the subject arrived in the UK on a Tier 4 Student valid from 28/01/2011 until 29/06/2012.

The subject had not made any further application to regularise his stay and has not made any arrangement to leave the UK.

Therefore subject has breached section 10(1)a of the I&AA1999 .

Subject was arrested and later admitted to working.

Chief Immigration Officer authorised the subjects detention pending referral to Detention Gatekeeper.

The owners name identified from letters at the scene as Annar Malik. No other details found.

2 males outside started banging on the front door and windows and then went to the rear of the premises to confront the officers. At this point police were called for assistance.

1 of the males stated he had left his laptop in the shop as he works there. Police were not satisfied with the males account and refused to hand over the laptop. This was left on top of a crate in the shop.

As the offender was the only person in the shop the premises was secured using keys. The keys were booked into custody with subject.

Subject conveyed to Blackburn Greenbank and all officers left at 18:47 hrs.

There is a civil penalty for £15,000 which is currently outstanding.
