Key Decisions

Notice to Scrutiny Committee Chair under Regulation 10 (1) (a)

The Council is required to give 28 days' notice if it intends to make a key decision. If it is impracticable to comply with this requirement it must inform the Chair of the Scrutiny Committee and publish a copy of that notice at least 5 days before the decision is taken.
