69. Health and Safety Intervention Plan Reviewed 2017-18

Purpose	The regulatory team responsible for Health & Safety at Work enforcement must have in place an intervention plan to meet the requirements of statutory guidance. This report formally consults the Committee on the plans prior to their approval at Full Council.
Reason for Decision	Section 18 of the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 and the subsequent National Local Authority Enforcement Code for Health and Safety (The Code) provide frameworks within which the Environmental Health & Licensing Team must operate when carrying out its public protection duties within workplaces. The frameworks require the Council to have plans in place to control these activities, and mechanisms for review. The intervention plan appended to this report has been prepared to satisfy the statutory requirements.
Decision	That Full Council be recommended to approve the Health and Safety Intervention Plan (reviewed 2017/2018), detailed at Appendix 1 to this report.
